

## **SAMPLE CIF PROGRAM OUTCOME SUMMARY**

### **OUTCOMES**

1. Students will reach high standards, at a minimum attaining proficiency or better in reading/language arts and mathematics.
2. Students will demonstrate improvements in homework completion, classroom participation, and school connectivity.
3. Students will not engage in violent acts at school.

### **MEASUREMENT**

Indicators: 1) KS State Assessment Data, 2) Teacher Survey, 3) District Suspension/Expulsion Rates

Data Collection: 1) First/Fourth quarter, 2) April 2009, 3) Monthly

Participants: All regular attendees (30 days +)

### **RESULTS**

1. **Benchmark:** 80% of students will reach high standards, at a minimum attaining proficiency or better, on the KS state assessments.  
**FY09 Results:** The program achieved its target in FY09 for mathematics but did not achieve its target for reading. 65% of students reached proficiency in reading; 85% of students reached high standards in mathematics.
2. **Benchmark:** 60% of students will demonstrate improvements in homework completion, classroom participation, and school connectivity.  
**FY09 Results:** The program achieved its target in all three domains: Teachers reported 65% of students improved in homework completion, 70% of students improved in classroom participation, and 62% improved in school connectivity.
3. **Benchmark:** 40% of students will not be suspended.  
**FY09 Results:** The program did not achieve its goal of limiting suspensions. Fifty percent of students involved in the program were suspended during the FY09 year.
